Meeting called to order by chairman Terry Tatro at 7pm.

Taylor presented a proposal for the Alburgh Village Master Plan from VHB. The PC went over the proposal with Taylor, addressing any concerns and changes. Most notably, the Walkability study previously scheduled for May 12th will be moved to a later date and will be performed with VHB. The proposal costs more than previously budgeted but still within our grant funds. VHB will perform the Walkability Study and Public Visioning Session possibly at the June PC meeting. Tentative plan is to start the PC meeting at 6pm with introductions and any clarifications between PC and VHB and a public walk at 7pm followed immediately with the visioning session. The school will have a logo design contest among students to aid the PC/VHB in developing a community logo. Gift cards will be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd place designs. Reclassifying a small section of Main Street from a Class 1 Road was also discussed. Taylor mentioned more flexibility/town control as the main reason for a town reclassifying. All meetings with VHB will be publicized through the Messenger, FPF and the Islander.

Beth made the motion to approve the minutes from the March 20th meeting as presented. Brian 2nd. All in favor, motion carried.
