7:00pm meeting called to order.

Taylor was discussing possible Municipal Planning Grants for Alburgh. The PC chose to pursue either a Construction Plan for Village Master Plan, Stormwater needs assessment, or Recreation Field Development. Taylor does not believe we can apply for a construction plan with a MPG, but he will check and get back to us. Also, the state is giving priority to projects that have an emphasis on healthy and wellness. He will let us know which of the three above best fits with the grant requirements and present at the next Selectboard meeting to gain their approval for the project. As part of the MPG Alburgh was awarded previously, Taylor will present basic village zoning at the Oct 16th meeting with the final zoning plan to present to the SB in February.

Mark presented the Village Master Plan Rough Draft. The final will be presented to the PC at their November 15th meeting.

Taylor also presented two logos for the PC to choose from. PC chose draft A. Alburgh on Lake Champlain. Live, work and play on the 45th parallel.

Carol presented a grant application for an electric vehicle charging station.
