Public Forum: Taylor Newton, NRPC Senior Planner presented the Master Village Plan. Some comments, questions, concerns: burying power lines to make Alburgh look nicer, interest in reclassifying small section of Route 2, truck/traffic concerns for pedestrians safety. Taylor will submit the plan to the Selectboard in June for approval.

Municipal Planning Grant: PC will revisit this with Taylor in July.

John made the motion to accept the February 21st and March 19th minutes as presented. Carol 2nd. All in favor, motion carried.

Electric car charging update: Carol passed out paper copies and will also email the PC so that everyone has a chance to read and give feedback before she submits it to the Selectboard at their next meeting. Upon the approval of the Selectboard, the grant will be submitted to the state and the decision will be made in July.
