Meeting adjourned at 5:50pm.







Meeting called to order at 6:01PM. Meeting moderated by Terry Tatro. Meeting began with Terry reading the warning as follows,

*Shall the voters of the Alburgh Town School District raise no more than \$40,000 to be raised by taxation for the operation of a village school bus for the year beginning July 1, 2015?*


Questions are as follows:

- How many students are in the village? Approximately 30
- Will it cost \$40,000? This warning says, up to \$40,000. This figure is based on the other busses that are running and we won't know an exact figure until we determine the route
- How many busses do we currently have? 2 are running right now
- Do we currently bus pre-k? No, it is unsafe to have pre-k children on the bus because the bus driver cannot see them over the seats
- Are the current busses full? Could they absorb the village children? At least one bus is full to capacity. The other is nearly full. Neither bus can accommodate the amount of students that live in the village as-is
- Have we sought out any other options? Yes, Safe Routes to school is actively being looked into


