MINUTES FROM 07/26/2016 SELECTBOARD MEETING

PRESENT: Chairman Tyler Gotshall, Robert Creller, Alton Bruso, Lee Kimball (via phone), Chuck Pease

7PM - OPEN MEETING:

At 7:01pm Chairman Gotshall called the meeting to order.

1. ADJUST THE AGENDA (if needed):

- ➤ Clerk had several adjustments Adjustments will be noted as such.
- Alton Bruso had two adjustments. Each adjustment will be noted as such.

ADJUSTMENT #1 – HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT TRUCK BREAKDOWN

Alton wanted to inform the Board that one of the highway trucks, the one ton that is used to plow the Village among other things, had broken down the previous week. The issue that caused the breakdown was something to do with the wiring. The cost to repair the wiring is an estimated \$3,000. This truck needs a new box as well, as it is rusty and falling apart. Alton recommended that they expend the money to get the wiring done, if that resolves the issue and the truck will run, then the subject of replacing the box can be discussed. This sounded reasonable to all of the Board. No motion was made. Unanimous agreement to expend \$3,000 to fix the wiring.

ADJUSTMENT #2 – HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT – EQUIPMENT VANDALIZED

Alton made the Board aware that the windows in the Samsung excavator had been smashed while the equipment was on Littlewoods Road. The insurance company has been made aware of this and the matter is being taken care of. Alton recommends that the equipment be garaged at night and not be left out. The Board agreed.

2. VISITOR INPUT:

- Lee Kimball, on behalf of Laura Limoge would like to ask that the yellow "paint" at the intersection of Martell Road and Greenwoods Road be "repainted" as it is wearing off and getting more difficult to see. Alton informed the Board that he believes that intersection will be addressed by the Rural Roads organization when they redo the signs through the Greenwoods. Alton also noted that a sign to identify a hidden driveway for West bound traffic would also be beneficial.
 - ✓ Alton Bruso motioned that the Town Highway Department restripe two areas on Greenwoods Road and that the Town Highway Department order and install a sign on Greenwoods Road indicating a hidden driveway seconded by Bobby Creller all in favor motion carried. Both sides of the hill that crests at Martell Road will be restriped a hidden driveway sign will be installed on Greenwoods Road East of Martell Road intersection.

- There was some discussion about the job requirements, pay rate and if there was going to be a primary and secondary ACO. These are all details that will be finalized when a new ACO is appointed.
- Clerk will advertise the position in the Islander and on Front Porch Forum.
- Lee Kimball presented to the Board a proposed Animal Control Officer job description so interested parties would have an idea of what the job entailed. All Board members read the proposed job description.
- Alton Bruso motioned that the Animal Control Officer job description proposed by Lee Kimball be adopted by the Town of Alburgh seconded by Tyler Gotshall all in favor motion carried.
- ➤ Alburgh Public Library Items needing attention update
 - Rick Baker is working on the ramp and should complete it in the near future.

 - ♣ No decision has been made on the windows.

➤ PURCHASE OF TRAILER FOR HAULING: Update – Board decision

- Lee summarized the condition of the trailer and box. He consulted with Jim Blair and Amy Mashtare about the condition of it as he was looking at it. Both the trailer and the box have some surface rust but nothing that creates a hole. Mechanical parts on the trailer seem to be in working order and the trailer doors will need a slight adjustment to make them shut tight.
- The container is loaded at this time with C&D. Templeton Salvage has assured

 Lee that it will be emptied prior to pick up if the Town makes the purchase.

- It was recommended that the bottom of the container be inspected when it is empty to be sure that it is sound.
- ♣ The Selectboard is in agreement that the purchase of this trailer and container would be a good investment.
- Lee, acting for the Selectboard originally offered Templeton Salvage \$10,000, that the Board agreed was reasonable. Templeton Salvage declined and countered with \$10,750, the lowest amount of they would be willing to accept.
- Lee Kimball motioned that, contingent upon the condition of the bottom of the container and the container being emptied, that the Town expend \$10,750 for the purchase of the trailer and container from Templeton Salvage seconded by Chuck Pease all in favor motion carried –
- Lee Kimball will continue to be the point of contact with Templeton Salvage and James Blair.
- → Jim is willing to pick up the trailer and container for the Town and haul it back.
- Lee Kimball will coordinate between Jim Blair, Templeton Salvage and the Selectboard to orchestrate the details of the pick-up.

ADJUSTMENT #3 – **COMPLAINT**:

- Clerk presented a complaint from Robert Barnum. He was concerned about a motorhome that is parked in his neighbor's yard with weeds growing around it and trash cans behind it. Clerk showed pictures that had been submitted.
- There was some discussion and the pictures were reviewed. The Board members did not feel that there was a violation of any of the Town ordinances.

 Creller all in favor motion carried Clerk to send a letter to Robert Barnum.

ADJUSTMENT #4 - STREETLIGHT CHANGE OVER TO LED -

- ➤ The Clerk presented information from Efficiency Vermont and Vermont Electric Coop to the Board explaining what the cost as well as the future cost savings to the Town would be by switching the Town streetlights to LED.
- ➤ The initial cost for changing the four Town streetlight to LED would be \$700. Efficiency Vermont would provide \$400 of that, leaving a cost to the Town of \$300. The estimated payoff is about 15 months and it would be approximately a \$20 per month savings after that.
 - Alton Bruso motioned to approve the LED streetlight upgrade and the expenditure of
 \$300 for that upgrade seconded by Bobby Creller all in favor motion carried.

ADJUSTMENT #5 – BRUSH REMOVAL FOR BICENTENNIAL PARK –

- ➤ Wright's Cut and Clean submitted a quote to trim the trees and brush in Bicentennial Park the cost is estimated to be between \$1,000 \$1,200.
- ➤ The Board would like to have a site visit with Wright's Cut and Clean so both parties can be certain of what work will be completed for the money. Alton and either Bobby or Chuck will conduct the on-site inspection and assessment.

The skating rink will be moved in mid or late August.
