

# MINUTES FROM 01/18/2017 MEETING FOR TRANSFER STATION TOPICS

## **TRANSFER STATION DISCUSSIONS:**

- Amy presented a proposed yearly report to be included in the Annual Report.
- The report will show what has been happening at the Transfer Station through the year and also changes that might be taking place.
- A couple of changes were suggested for the format of the report.
- The Selectboard agree that it will be a positive addition to the Town Report.
- The group discussed pricing of each item at the Transfer Station and made suggested changes to better offset disposal costs.
- *Tyler Gotshall motioned to adopt the new pricing beginning February 1<sup>st</sup>, 2017 on all items as suggested – seconded by Lee Kimball – all in favor – motion carried.*
- *Chuck Pease motioned that the Transfer Station begin accepting food scraps as of February 1<sup>st</sup>, 2017 – seconded by Lee Kimball – all in favor – motion carried.*
- There was some discussion about the pricing that had been set to accept food scrap. The Board agreed to change the originally approved price.
- *Tyler Gotshall motioned to change the food scrap pricing to be .15¢per pound for residents and .20¢ per pound for non-residents – seconded by Chuck Pease- all in favor – motion carried.*

- New pricing can be found at the Transfer Station or at the Town Clerk's Office.

#### **VISITOR INPUT:**

- There was some discussion about the price of metal and the hauling cost associated with shipping it.
- Amy will investigate other options for metal.
- There was some discussion about hiring Paul Pouliot as a per diem snowplow driver.
- It was suggested that the position should be advertised out to the public to give other qualified candidates an opportunity to apply.
- Clerk will place an ad in the Islander for the position, and run the ad until February 7<sup>th</sup>.
- Tabled until the meeting on February 13<sup>th</sup> 2017.
