6:03pm – J. Henry Called the meeting to order

- Adjustments to the Agenda. Moving all executive session topics to end of meeting
- Review of minutes from 08/18/24. Elliot motions to approve minutes as amended. Josie seconds. All in favor, so moved.

6:08pm – Animal Control Officer Interview: Nancy Blaise

 Nancy introduced herself to the board and public. The board asked her questions regarding her interest in the position.

6:15pm – SBA representative did not attend meeting. Town Administrator to post SBA information packet to Town Website for public viewing of disaster relief information / support.

6:17pm – Ed Weeks – Junk Ordinance Violation update

- Mr. Weeks unable to produce registrations for vehicles requested from last board meeting
  - o Mr. Week states two of the vehicles have been removed, but needs more time
  - Dialogue continued, Mr. Weeks was found out of order and exited the meeting at

#### 6:24pm Highway Department

- Grant Aid Application approval as of 08/24/23 to research qualifying expenses to apply grant funding to
  - o Grant is an 80/20 match. Award: \$33,750 Town match: \$6,750
  - Need to compile list of manpower hours, etc to apply to funding
- New Tandem Purchase
  - Total cost of purchasing approximately \$330,000
  - Board Discussed finance options, and cash on hand in Highway Fund
  - Public Discussion and comments on number of highway vehicles that are seemingly redundant in operations, and questions of need for new equipment
    - Board discussed future options of contracting out more work
  - o RD all equipment serves a specific purpose, and is needed for operations
  - Elliot Knight motions to apply \$90,000 of the \$240,000 Highway Surplus fund as down payment on Tandem, to finance the rest through the dealership or alternative loan funding option with lowest interest rate, and to apply for State

Grant for \$110,000 at 2% interest rate after purchase to apply to loan. Josie seconds. All in favor, so moved.

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- Rolloff Container: in disrepair, Russell to engage local contractors capable of repairing
- C&D: Russell to research how to make C&D section of transfer station more operationally effective. Quote and plan for next meeting
- Revenue at 150% of anticipated, Transfer station running well under new management and hard work of Transfer Station employees. Russell reports morale is up.

- VLCT Training Conference board approves Town Clerks, Treasurer, Administrator, and Selectboard Chair to attend. Valuable training and information to bring back to Town operations

  - 183 East Alburgh Tenant / Landlord dispute has engaged the Town Attorney at a cost. Man-hours spent for Town Officials has been consuming.
