

Corrugated cardboard looks like this (see the air pockets between sheets) and should be separated to the baler room and out of generic recycling. Please flatten boxes and remove any packing materials within



This is boxboard/paperboard and CAN go in main recycling. Please don't include with corrugated cardboard

#### HELPFUL TRASH DISPOSAL TIPS

- 1. Leaving bags out in the elements makes the plastic weaker and attracts wildlife. Try to keep trash secure before you bring it to the transfer station
- 2. Be prepared to move to your vehicle to the side of traffic if your load is too mixed to dispose of in a reasonable time frame
- 3. Please do not block entrance and exit, leave enough room for vehicles to move around you in a timely fashion. If you have a lot or large items, please be patient
- 4. Transfer Station attendants will gladly help elderly and injured patrons but are not solely responsible for unloading vehicles
